



#### One Man, Two Guvnors 30 Sept – 4 Oct 2025

Congleton Players' first production of our 2025/26 season will be the Richard Bean comedy *One Man, Two Guvnors,* to be directed by Louise Colohan. The play will be staged at Daneside Theatre from Tue 30<sup>th</sup> September to Sat 4<sup>th</sup> October. This will be the second time we have performed this play; it was hugely popular the last time and was a sell out, with a waiting list for tickets! Safe to say it is "back by popular demand!"

### Summary

Fired from his skiffle band, Francis Henshall becomes minder to Roscoe Crabbe, a small time East End hood, now in Brighton to collect £6,000 from the dad of his fiancee. But Roscoe is really his sister Rachel posing as her own dead brother, who has been killed by her boyfriend Stanley Stubbers.

Holed up at The Cricketers Arms, the permanently ravenous Francis spots the chance of an extra meal ticket and takes a second job with one Stanley Stubbers, who is hiding from the police and waiting to be reunited with Rachel. To prevent discovery, Francis must keep his two guvnors apart. Simple.

Based on the classic Italian comedy *II Servitore di Due Padroni* (The Servant of Two Masters) by Carlo Goldoni, in this new English version by prizewinning playwright Richard Bean, with songs and music by Grant Olding, sex, food and money are high on the agenda.

# Arrangements for casting
